Solomon	son of David, 3rd king of Israel, builds temple
WWW	wives, wealth, warfare - the 3 warnings given from God about kings
Ecclesiastes	*Not ecclesiasticus/ sirach // book of wisdom suffering & the end of life,
Jeroboam	First king of Northern Kingdom Israel who confronted Rehoboam and led kingdom to divide (Solomon's servant)
Rehoboam	son of Solomon, king who allowed kingdom to divide
Judah	The south kingdom (Benjamin & Judah)
Israel	The North Kingdom (the other 10 tribes)
